and how to install them

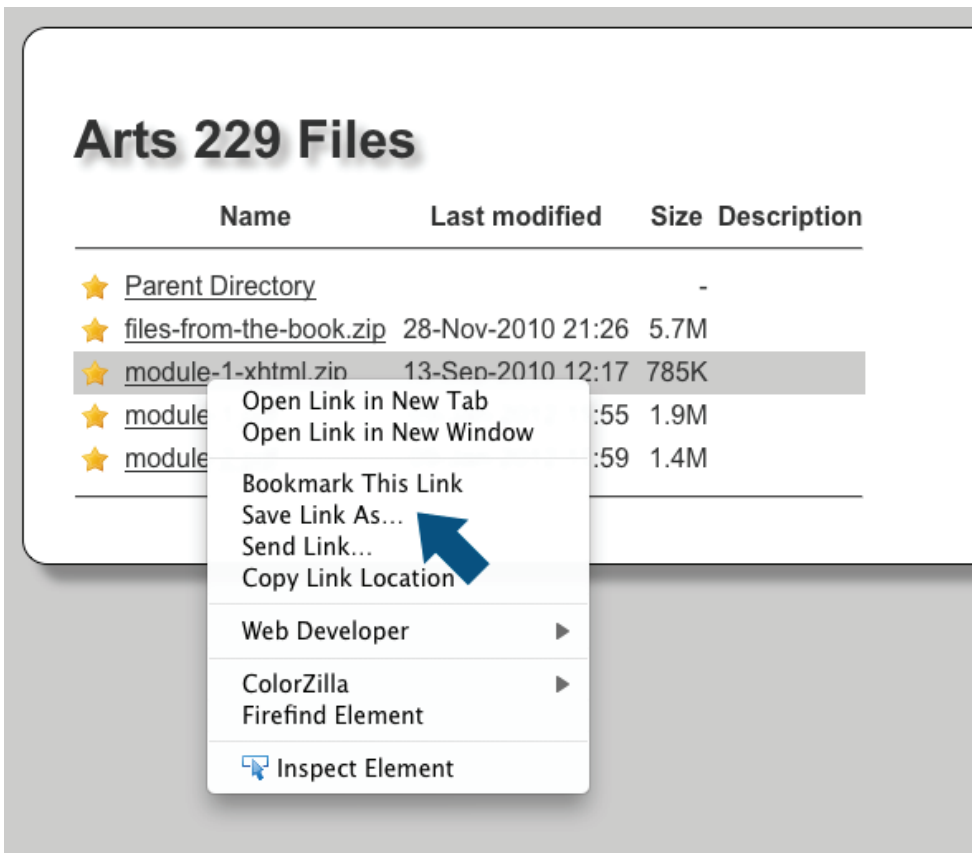
Way back in ARTS173 all the demo files were installed for you from day one. However, this is not the case in ARTS229. In ARTS229, the demo files live as ZIP files on the web server and it's up to the student to download them into the correct folder. Why is this? What kind of cruel, heartless jerk came up with this ruthless scheme?

Put the knife down and let me explain. Back when you took ARTS173 you were just a tenderfoot but now you're a grizzled veteran. Why, some students in ARTS173 didn't even know there was a difference between a single and double click. I am not making that up. I figured DreamWeaver was a little intimidating to some students so I decided to have DreamWeaver ready to go from day one. I had some things setup for you so you wouldn't freak out. If you're taking ARTS229 then you're probably going to do some of this web stuff for real and as such, you're going to use ZIP files a lot. Therefore, I decided to force the issue and make all the modules into individual ZIP files. You can thank me later.

Here's a step by step on getting a module file into DreamWeaver.

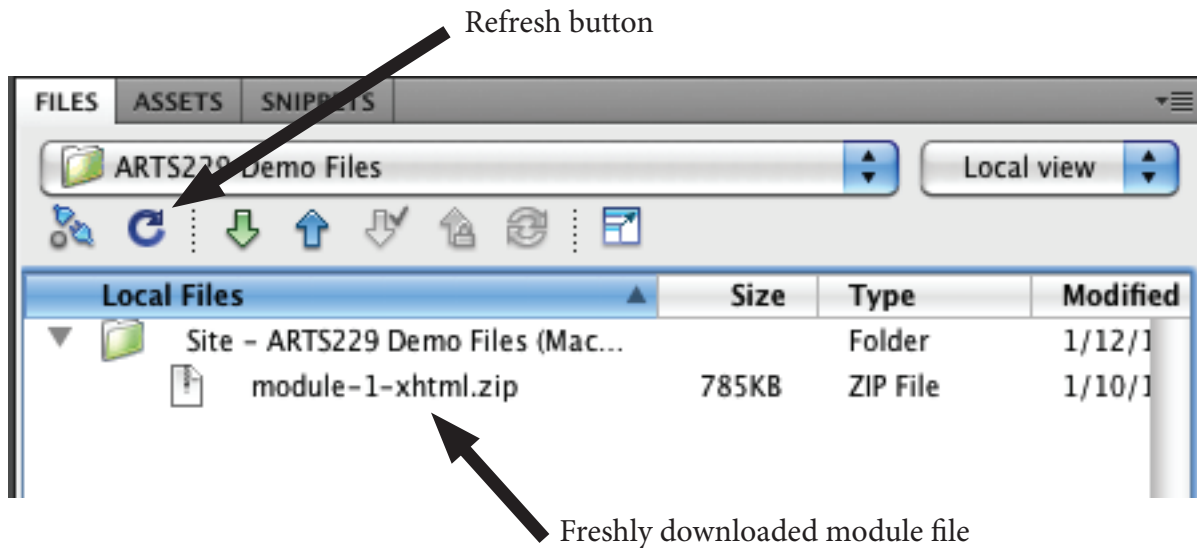
1) Open a browser and navigate to the folder that has all the module in it. This may change over time so let's write it down here:

Right click on the module you want to install. Different browsers will give slightly different contextual menus but they'll all be close to the screen cap below. Slide down to Save Link As... and click.



2) Go ahead and save that file into your local site folder.

3) Go back to DreamWeaver and make sure you're in your demo site. You should see the new module listed but if not click the refresh button in the sites window.



4) Double click on the new module you just downloaded. There will be a short pause and like magic, your module will appear. And like step 3, you might have to click the refresh button to see it.
